



# Grow your own Onions

2026 GRANGE SUPPLY ONION TRANSPLANT VARIETIES



**AILSA CRAIG**

This huge, 2 pound, 6-8 inch, straw yellow globe onion is amazingly sweet and firm for its size. Perfect for burgers and salads. Long-day variety. Days to harvest: 95. Size: 8". Storage: 1 month.



**CANDY**

Up to 6-inch bulbs, 2-foot tops. Not affected by day length, it is called a day-neutral variety. The jumbo, globe-shaped bulbs are sweet and mild with lasting quality and good flavor. Days to harvest 90-100. Size: 6". Storage: 3 months.



**HIGHLANDER**

Excellent yield potential with primarily jumbo production. Highlander is tolerant to botrytis and downy mildew, the two most common diseases in onions. Days to harvest: 90. Size: 3-4". Storage: 4-5 months.



**PATTERSON**

Patterson provides great storage potential, firmness, with larger size potential, better uniformity, and higher yield potential compared to Copra. Days to harvest 110-115. Size: 3-4". Storage: 3-5 months.



**RED RIVER**

Red River onion plants boasts a strong root system and a nice dark, red color. High yield potential and good storage potential. Resistant to pink root, fusarium, and bolting. Days to harvest: 95. Size: 3-4". Storage: 3-5 months.



**RED ZEPPELIN**

This long day hybrid onion plant produces large, round, richly dark red to purple onions with a slightly pungent flavor that will add attractive color to any dish. Days to harvest: 100-110. Size: 3-4". Storage: 6-8 months.



**RINGMASTER**

Globe shaped with white skin and flesh. Earlier harvest time, can be planted densely for great scallions or green onions. Days to harvest: 100. Size: 5". Storage: 4-5 months.



**WALLA WALLA**

A short keeper, Walla Walla is best used soon after harvest for fresh eating, cooking or freezing. Days to harvest: 90. Size: 6". Storage: 1 month.



**YELLOW SPANISH**

Heavy yields and good, sweet flavor make this variety a garden favorite. They grow as big as they taste, weighing up to 1 lb. Days to harvest: 100. Size: 6". Storage: 4 months.



**LANCELOT LEEKS**

The long, white shafts have a dark blue/green upright flag. The 12-14 inch shaft provides a distinct flavor to your soups and salads. Days to harvest: 75. Size: 12-14" shafts.
